#### **SPORTS CAMP 2022**

Sports Camp provides an opportunity for our keen sportspeople to compete in a range of sports against other athletes with similar abilities. <u>This is for Year 8's ONLY in 2022</u>

Camp: Totara Springs - 288 Taihoa North Road, Taihoa 3473

Dates: Monday 27th June - Friday 1st July

All students attending trials for sports camp will need to complete the google form which is attached <u>here</u>.

The selection process for these teams will begin in <u>Week 1 of Term 2</u>. We have many talented athletes at NIS but we are only able to take a maximum of <u>38</u> students to camp.

Students interested in being considered to represent NIS will take part in a number of trials.

Trial schedule:

- Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> May (Term 2, Week 1): Full day trial 9.00am to 3.00pm
- The remainder of trials will be held during break times, before or after school of Week 1 & 2 of Term 2

The group of students selected will need to be **all-round** sportspeople, competent at a range of sports, have an excellent **attitude** (including classroom behaviour), and demonstrate a high level of **sportsmanship**. An exceptional standard of behaviour is expected, as the team will be representing the school and be part of a large group of students taking part in the five-day camp.

The selected athletes will be required to take part in a range of the sports listed below: Athletics, Archery, Basketball, Bowls, Caged Soccer, Croquet, Cross Country, Darts, Draughts and Chess, Hole-In-One Golf, Hockey, Indoor Hockey, Indoor Soccer, Kayaking, Netball, Petanque, Rugby, Shooting, Soccer, Softball, Swimming, Table Tennis, Tennis, Touch Rugby, Volleyball and Wallball.

The cost of the camp will be **approximately** \$450.00 to \$550.00 (costs will be confirmed once squad is confirmed). This cost covers transport, accommodation, food, clothing, all sporting activities, camp facilities, and NIS staff supervisors for the whole week of attendance.
