School Uniform: As a school we are endeavouring to streamline our uniform system to coincide with our specified team P.E days. In past years, we have found that uniform standards have taken a downturn, so to show pride in ourselves and to prepare our students for high school expectations (wearing formal uniform daily and bringing P.E uniform on allocated days) this is our kaupapa for 2024.

In Terms 1 and 4 students need to be sun smart – this includes wearing hats, sunblock, restricting exposure to sun and covering up. Please ensure your child comes to school with either a plain blue or school hat.

Also, we are a water only school. There are many water fountains around the school for students to use, and we recommend students bring their own, named drink bottle to help keep them hydrated. Please note that bubble or chewing gum is not permitted at school.

@School App: It's great to see people using the app to notify us of absences through the app feature. The school calendar is also connected to the app, as are the daily notices and EZ lunch. The school app does not replace our other methods of communication. If you haven't received log in details to install the app, please email admin@ni.school.nz

Payment of school accounts and sports fees: Our school is a Kindo school which means you can pay for all your school costs easily; order lunches, register and pay for sports fees, view your family account, all using the same login details.

To make a school payment, log into Kindo via the @school app or the Kindo app and click on the 'Fees & Donations' icon. You have the option of paying the amount in full or making a part payment on some items.

To register for a sports team, log into Kindo and scroll down to the 'Sports' tab. Registration and payment for seasonal sports must be completed before your child can trial.
